

## FLAG

	DESCRIPTION
<b>Format</b>	<b>Individual</b> competition, <b>strokeplay</b> rules.
<b>Scoring</b>	<b>Strokeplay (medal)</b> .
<b>Handicap Strokes Received</b>	<b>Full</b> playing handicap

This is a normal strokeplay competition, like a “medal”, however each player carries with them a flag mounted on a stick. When the player has taken the number of strokes equal to the **par of the course** (71 at Minthis Hills) **plus his/her handicap** they will have finished the round and must plant the flag in the position described in the table below.

FINAL BALL POSITION	WHERE TO PLANT THE FLAG
<b>On the fairway,tee or green</b>	<b>The spot at which the ball lies</b>
<b>In the hole</b>	<b>On the green, as close as possible behind the hole without damaging it.</b>
<b>In the rough or a bunker</b>	<b>On the fairway, tee or green at the nearest point (not nearer the hole) to where the ball lies</b>
<b>In a water (or lateral water) hazard</b>	<b>On the fairway, tee or green at the nearest point (not nearer the hole) to where the ball last crossed the margin of the hazard</b>
<b>Lost or out of bounds</b>	<b>On the fairway or tee at the point from which the ball was last played. If the ball was not played from the fairway or tee (e.g. rough), see above.</b>

**You must record the gross score** on each hole in “Score” column A.

**You should indicate on the scorecard the hole on which you planted your flag.**

If you hole out on the 18<sup>th</sup> hole and still have a number of shots remaining (unused), you should record this number in the “Stableford Points” cell at the far lower right of the scorecard.

Once you have planted your flag play the remaining holes, but the scores on these holes do not count.

**Both the marker and the player must sign the card.**

The winner is the player who carries his/her flag the longest distance from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee, or, if they finish with shots unused, the one with the most shots left.
